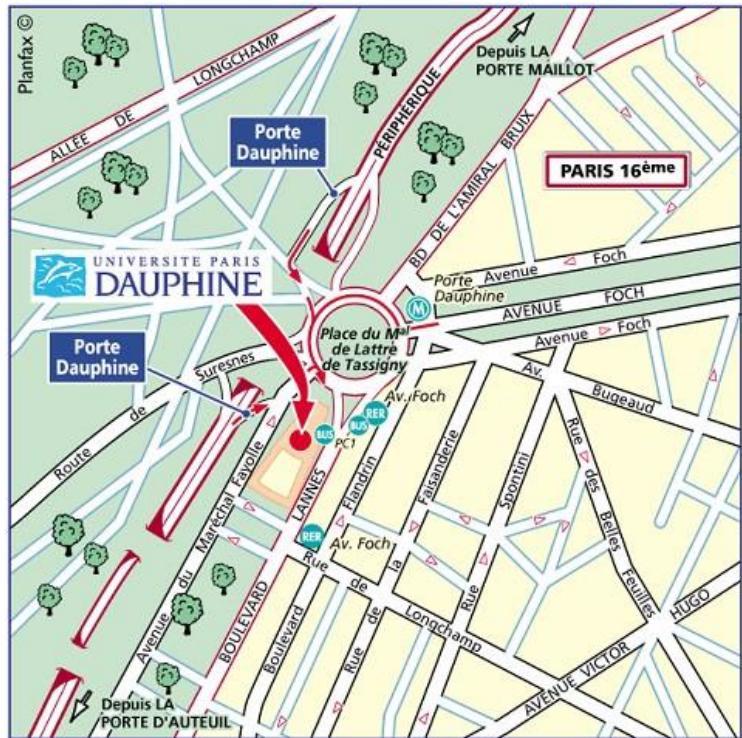

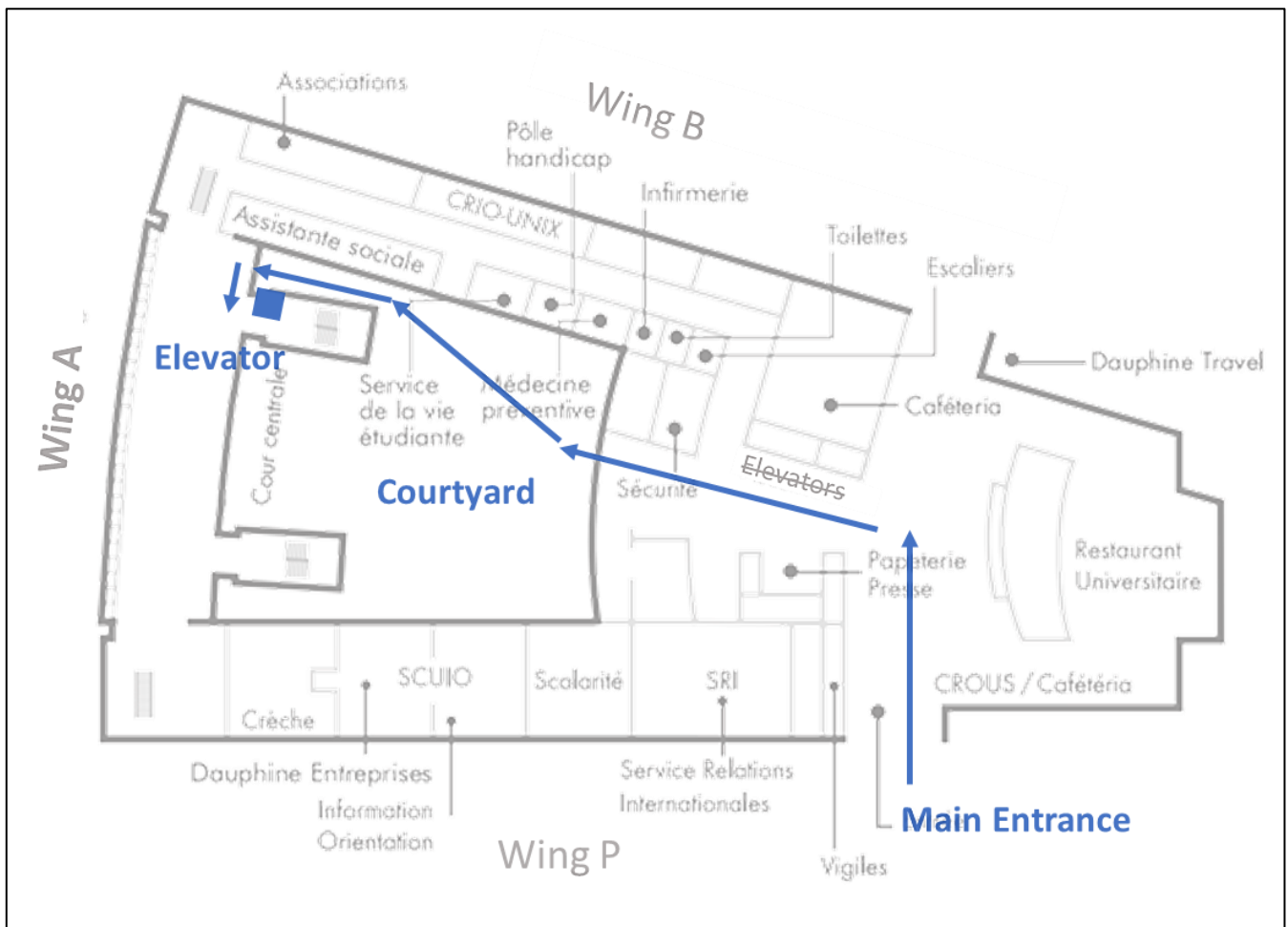
Closest underground / bus stations:

- The workshop takes place on the 7th floor of the A wing.
- Enter the University through the main entrance on Boulevard Lannes.
